[06] Among the people is he who purchases amusement of speech to mislead [others] from the way of Allāh without knowledge and who takes it in ridicule. For them there will be a humiliating punishment.

[07] And when our āyāt are recited to him, he turns away arrogantly as though he had not heard them, as if there was deafness in his ears. So, give him tidings of a painful punishment.

[08] Indeed, those who have imān and do righteous deeds – for them are gardens of bliss.

[09] They will abide therein eternally; the promise of Allāh, in truth. And he is the exalted in greatness, the all-wise.

[10] He created the heavens without pillars that you see and cast into the earth firmly set mountains, lest it shift with you, and he dispersed therein every kind of creature. And we sent down rain from the sky and made grow therein [plants] of every noble kind.

[11] This is the creation of Allāh. So, show me what those besides him have created. Rather, the wrongdoers are in clear error.

[12] And we certainly gave Luqmān wisdom: "Be grateful to Allāh." Whoever is grateful is grateful for his own [benefit]. And whoever is ungrateful – indeed, Allāh is free of need, and is praiseworthy.

[13] And when Luqmān said to his son while he was counselling him, "O my son, do not associate [anything] with Allāh. Indeed, shirk is a terrible wrongdoing."

[14] And we have commanded people to be good to their parents. Their mothers carried them, weakness upon weakness, and their weaning is two years. Be grateful to me and to your parents; to me is the [final] destination.

[15] But if they both endeavour to make you associate with me that of which you have no knowledge, then do not obey them; but behave with them in [this] world with appropriate kindness; and follow the way of those who are devout. Then to me is your return, and I will inform you about what you used to do.

[16] [Luqmān said], "O my son, indeed if wrong should be the weight of a mustard seed and should be within a rock or [anywhere] in the heavens or in the earth, Allāh will bring it forth. Indeed, Allāh is subtle and acquainted.

[17] O my son, establish ṣalāh, enjoin what is right, forbid what is wrong, and be patient over what befalls you. Indeed, [all] that is of the matters [requiring] determination.

[18] And do not turn your cheek [in contempt] at people and do not walk on the earth arrogantly. Indeed, Allāh does not like any self-deluded boaster.

[19] And be moderate in your pace and lower your voice; indeed, the most repulsive of voices is the braying of donkeys."

[20] Do you not see that Allāh has made useful for you what is in the heavens and what is on the earth, and has lavished his blessings upon you, both outwardly and inwardly? But some people dispute about Allāh without knowledge or guidance or an enlightening scripture.

[21] And when it is said to them, "Follow what Allah has revealed," they say, "Rather, we will follow what we found our forefathers upon." Even if shayṭān was inviting them to the punishment of the blaze?

[22] And whoever submits himself to Allāh while he is a doer of good – then he has grasped the most trustworthy handhold. And to Allāh will be the outcome of [all] matters.

[23] And whoever disbelieves – let not their disbelief grieve you. To us is their return, and we will inform them of what they did. Indeed, Allāh is all-knowing of that within the hearts.

[24] We grant them enjoyment for a little; then we will force them to a harsh punishment.

[25] And if you ask them, "Who created the heavens and earth?" they would surely say, "Allāh." Say, "All praise is for Allāh"; but most of them do not know.

[26] To Allāh belongs whatever is in the heavens and earth. Indeed, Allāh is the one free of need, the praiseworthy.

[27] If all trees upon the earth were pens and the sea [was ink], replenished thereafter by seven [more] seas, the words of Allāh would not be exhausted. Indeed, Allāh is exalted in greatness and all-wise.

[28] The creation and resurrection [of you all] is [only like the creation of] a single person. Indeed, Allāh is all-hearing and all-seeing.

[29] Do you not see that Allāh causes the night to enter the day and causes the day to enter the night, and has subjected the sun and the moon, each running [its course] for a specified term, and that Allāh is with whatever you do, all-acquainted?

[30] That is because Allāh is the truth, and what they invoke beside him is falsehood, and because Allāh is the most high, the grand.

[31] Do you not see that ships sail through the sea by the grace of Allāh, that he may show you some of his signs? Indeed, in that are signs for every patient and grateful [person].

[32] And when waves come over them like canopies, they invoke Allāh in sincere devotion. But when he delivers them to the land, only some are relatively grateful - and none rejects our signs except whoever is deceitful ungrateful.

[33] O mankind, have taqwa of your Lord and fear a day when no parent will avail their child, nor will a child avail their parent. Indeed, the promise of Allāh is true, so let not the worldly life delude you and be not deceived about Allāh by the deceiver.

[33] Indeed, Allāh [alone] has knowledge of the Hour and sends down the rain and knows what is in the wombs. And no soul perceives what it will earn tomorrow, and no soul perceives in which land it will die. Indeed, Allāh is all-knowing and well-acquainted.
